OVERVIEW





Bordered by the Gallatin River to the north and the 1.8 millionacre Gallatin National Forest to the south, the Preserve Ranches collection offers endless adventure and exploration, with convenient access to all of the Yellowstone Club amenities. Owners of a ranch in the Preserve Ranches will also need to become Yellowstone Club Members. This new addition of land is the most recent expansion to the Yellowstone Club property and an exciting opportunity for Members to have space and privacy with YC amenities at your fingertips.

- Infrastructure for 8 homesites plus caretaker site
- 1.2 miles of water frontage on the South Fork of the West Fork of the Gallatin River

YELLOW MULE RANCH | 160.37 ACRES

- Panoramic views including Lone Mountain, Spanish Peaks Range, the mouth of the canyon, and the shimmer of town lights along the valley floor
- Secluded access to the first Yellow Mule Valley with its trail system leading to Ousel Falls and more than 1.8 million acres in the Gallatin National Forest
- Trail to private South Fork river frontage trout filled pools

- Mature lodgpole pine forest and sprawling wildflower meadows
- Grand views of Lone Mountain, Spanish Peaks Range, the mouth of the canyon
- Private trails to the historic South Fork bridge and fishing camp with access to private trout-filled South Fork river frontage

- Mature stand of lodgepole pines with verdant forest floor covered in clover and mountain grasses
- Lone Mountain and Spanish Peaks Range views
- Hiking trail access from the property to the Gallatin National Forest

SOUTH FORK RANCH | 308.84 ACRES

- Top tier in the collection, offering the biggest views, the largest size at 310 acres, and the greatest seclusion
- Highest homesite in all of Gallatin County
- Views of cascading mountain ridges and hundreds of acres of wildlife filled meadows
- Hiking trail access from the property to the Gallatin National Forest
- Base camp for some of the best hunting, Nordic skiing, and snowmobiling in Big Sky







DUNRAVEN RANCH | 309.58 ACRES
