


The two-story home features stained-concrete floors and oak ceilings. In the living room, walls of glass offer unobstructed views of Lone Peak and the Spanish Peaks. A three-sided fireplace is the centerpiece of the room. The dining room, kitchen, master suite, and media room are also on the main floor. Two guest suites and a bunk room are located on the lower level.

Covered walkways connect the home to the garage, office, and deck, which showcases a cantilevered hot tub with staggering views of mountains and ski runs.




The glass-walled dining room looks out on the mountains.




The spacious kitchen has a breakfast bar.
