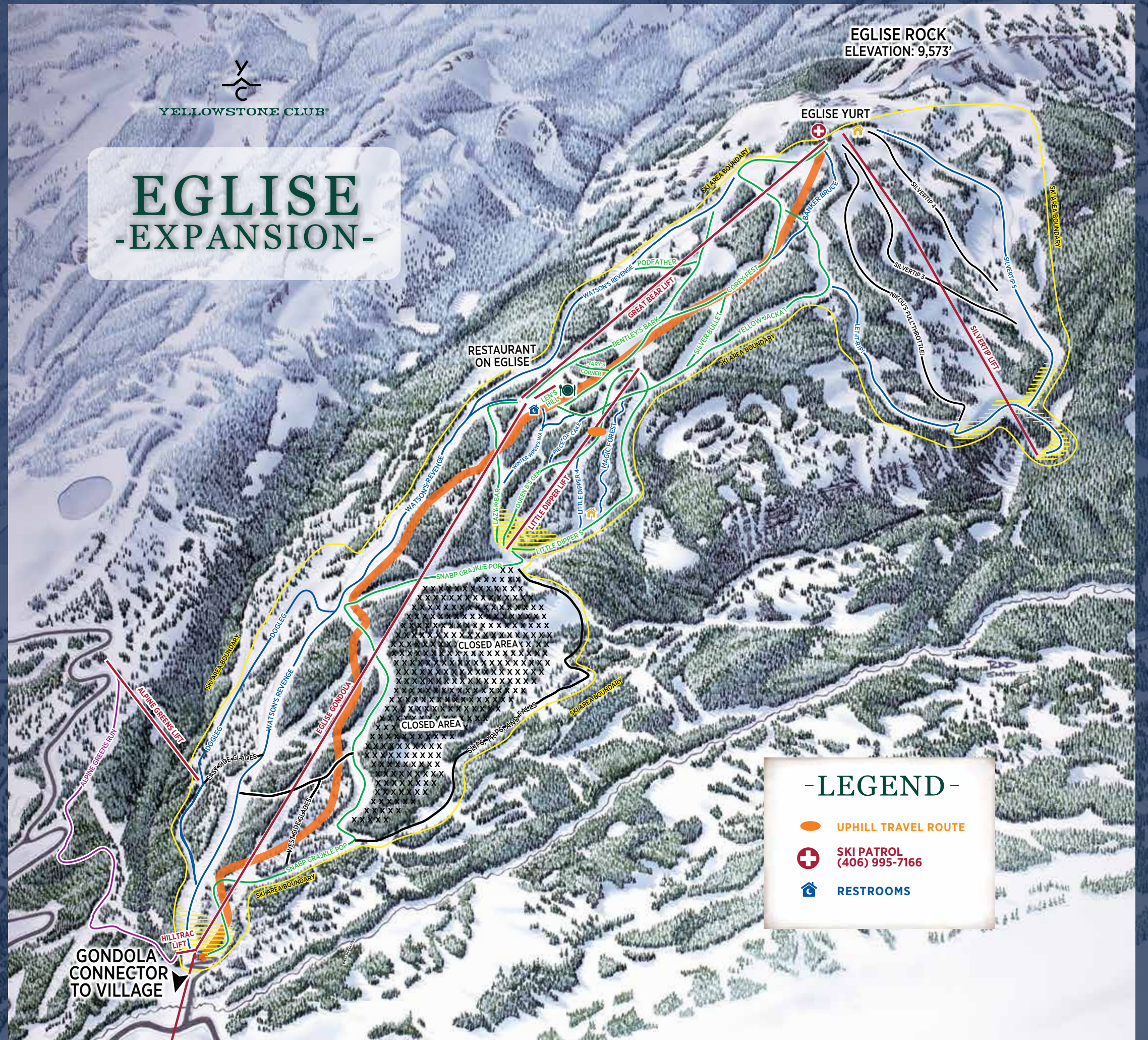

YELLOWSTONE CLUB UPHILL USE POLICY

Uphill Use of the ski area by means of skinning and snowshoeing is an activity that YC supports with certain restrictions. This policy does not apply to motorized vehicles or bicycles. The following guidelines are in place to promote safety and minimize conflicts with Mountain Operations, downhill skiers/riders, and any other activities that might be taking place on the mountain, day and night.

GENERAL

- All Uphill Users are subject to and must obey all YC Policies and the Montana Code including the Skier Responsibility Code.
- All Uphill Users are required to adhere to and obey all posted information and be aware of trail closures and other operational considerations.
- Snowmobiles, snow cats, winch cats, snow making equipment and other equipment may be encountered at any time.
- Be especially aware of other skiers and riders approaching from above or below when on-mountain. Be aware of limited site lines and use extra caution when crossing a ski run. Make yourself as visible as possible and bright clothing is recommended.
- Dogs are not allowed.
- Uphill rental gear such as skis, boots, and skins are available to rent at YC Outfitters. All other avalanche gear (beacon, shovel, probe) is for sale.

UPHILL ROUTES

EGLISE

The Eglise Uphill Route is only allowed during normal operating hours (9:00 AM – 3:30 PM) and only when the route is open for skiing during the ski season. The Eglise Uphill Route is marked and is designated on the Uphill Skiing Trail Map.

Uphill Users are to stay off to the side of the ski runs. The Route crosses several runs and Uphill Users are to look uphill and wait until skiers/riders go by before crossing.

ANDESITE

On Andesite, Pine Ridge, and Big Sky Ridge any ski run can be used for Uphill Use, but only after 4:30 PM and only during the time of the ski season when the terrain is open for skiing. Uphill Use is not allowed on Andesite, Pine Ridge, or Big Sky Ridge before or during operating hours (9:00 AM – 4:30 PM).

It is strongly encouraged to have some sort of light (head lamp or other) so that Uphill Users can be seen by Mountain Operations personnel after dark. This policy does not apply to Big Sky Ski Area, and users should not to go onto Big Sky property.

YC offers a variety of on-snow programs for outdoor enthusiasts of all ages and skill levels. All programs emphasize safety and enjoyment, foster individual growth, and teach technique and an appreciation for the environment.
